#### By Law Changes

During the November 9th meeting, at which we had a quorum of the membership present, we voted on several changes to the By-Laws. The changed articles are as follows:

Articles 5C & 5D have been added.

Article 5C Senior Citizens age 65 and over will pay half the senior member rate.

Article 5D A member in good standing who becomes unemployed, may be exempted from paying dues at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

Articles changed are:

Article 8 has been amended to drop the FCC license requirement.

Article 11 has been amended to add the following: In addition, the original four (4) founding and charter officers (the original 4 officers) of the Suburban RC Barnstormers, Inc. will also be granted lifetime membership provided (in the opinion of the Board of Directors) they remain active in at least 50% of annual club activities.
